Suburb



A supportive and connected community, there are high numbers of active volunteers in Luddenham.







Most people in Luddenham live in a separate house, there is no high-density housing and 3% of the population lives in caravans, cabins or houseboats.


















The majority of houses in Luddenham are owned outright or with a mortgage.










