10.5% of North St Marys population are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, a much higher proportion of the population compared to the wider Penrith City LGA (5%).






We have residents who need assistance and a higher number of people who are unemployed than the wider Penrith City LGA.

A slightly higher proportion (8.7%) of North St Marys residents need assistance due to disability, compared with **5.5%** of overall residents across the Penrith City LGA.



unemployment rate is **8.6%**, compared to 4.6% across the Penrith City LGA.

We have income inequality and high levels of mortgage and rental stress.

A significant proportion of people are experiencing mortgage and rental stress with payments that exceed 30% of their income.
